## 2010 Preview Show June 18 - 20, 2010 Rock Island County Fairgrounds in East Moline, IL

### ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN JUNE 1

All Announcements made during the show weekend will take precedence over any written publications

### Eligibility and General Rules

#### 1) Exhibitors

- At least 7 years of age and not 22 years old as of January 1, 2010
- An exhibitor must be a member of the IJHA and pay IJHA annual dues of \$10.00 if they are exhibiting animals in any classes or participating in any event.
- Appropriate dress will be enforced in the show ring. Ladies, no tank tops, spaghetti straps and gentlemen shirts tucked in etc.

#### 2) Show Animals

- Only the original AHA certificate of registration will be accepted at check in.
- Animals with scurs may show in the Polled Show.
- Health papers and registration certificates are required at check-in during cattle processing Friday and Saturday. Tattoos will be checked—missing, illegible, altered or incorrect tattoos may result in disqualification.
- Entries must meet the state health regulations of Illinois and any other states that are crossed.
- Exhibitors must show their own entries unless they have 2 in one class. The second animal must also be shown by a junior member.
- If any requirements are not satisfactorily met, the Show Committee reserves the right to disqualify any entries.
- **Heifers**—Calved on or after September 1, 2008 with recorded ownership by June 1, 2010
- **Cow/Calf** – no maximum age of cow. Calf must be her natural born calf and cannot be over 270 days of age as of the day of the show. Juniors must have been the owner of the cow at the time of the breeding for the calf.
- **Bulls** – Bred and Owned, calved on or after September 1, 2008
- **Steers**—Hereford steers born in 2009 and sired by a bull recorded in the register of the AHA. AHA Hereford Steer Certification papers required at check-in. A sifting committee will be in place, their decision is final. Steers will be weighed and classes divided after check-in.

#### 3) General

- **Entry Fees are \$25.00 per class and must be postmarked by June 1**
  - **LATE ENTRIES are \$50.00 per class – LATE ENTRY FEES WILL BE ENFORCED!**
- Exhibitors are responsible to keep stall area clean
- NO manure in the trash cans
- No smoking in the barns
- Generators suggested but must be outside of barns
- Cattle will be released at the conclusion of the show. No trailers near show barns or show arena for loading of equipment until the conclusion of the show.

#### 4) Contests

##### ● Showmanship Classes

- Pee Wee: 7-9 Years of age as of January 1, 2010
  - Junior: 10-13 Years of age as of January 1, 2010
  - Intermediate: 14-17 Years of age as of January 1, 2010
  - Senior: 18-21 Years of age as of January 1, 2010
- Sign up for Showmanship will be at check-in.
  - Classes may be divided into heats if the entries become numerous
  - Showmanship is a no-fit competition but the animals are required to be clean
  - Bulls cannot be shown in any showmanship class
  - When an individual wins a particular division, they may not compete again in that age division in future years. The winner may advance and compete in the next age division with exception of the winner of senior showmanship, who is ineligible for showmanship at IJHA preview shows.

##### ● Fitting Competition

- Pee Wee: 7-9 years of age as of January 1, 2010
    - Required to blow out the calf and prepare it for a no-fit show (no clipping)
    - Time: 20 minutes
  - Junior: 10-14 years of age as of January 1, 2010
    - Required to blow out the calf, lift legs and prepare calf for show ring up to final clipping (no clipping)
    - Time: 30 Minutes
  - Senior: 15-21 years of age as of January 1, 2010
    - Required to fit calf completely including clipping
    - Time: 45 Minutes
- Sign up for fitting contest will be at check in
  - One Illinois based fitter from each division will be awarded a place on the Illinois Fitting Team to compete at the 2010 Junior National Hereford Expo.
  - The competition is open to all juniors every year – previous winners are not required to advance to the next age division. The judges will choose an Illinois winner and alternate for each division.

##### ● Illustrated Speech Contest—sponsored by the Pollettes

###### **OBJECTIVES:**

1. To develop character and leadership in Hereford youth while stressing education.
2. To stimulate and promote interest in the beef industry.
3. To project Herefords in a positive image.

**TOPIC:** Any topic related to the beef industry

###### **AGE DIVISIONS**

Pee Wee: 7-9 years old as of January 1, 2010

Speech length: 2-4 minutes

Junior: 10-13 years old as of January 1, 2010

Speech length: 3-5 minutes

Intermediate: 14-17 years as of January 1, 2010

Speech length: 3-5 minutes  
Senior: 18-21 years of age as of January 1, 2010  
Speech length 6-8 minutes

Junior, Intermediate and Senior division winners qualify to go to the Junior National Hereford Expo in Indianapolis, Indiana and will be awarded a prize of \$25.00

All Peewee contestants are eligible to compete at the JNHE and will receive 10.00 for participating at the State Contest.

Illinois follows the guidelines of the National Speech Contest. Please refer to the National Rules for the Speech Contest. These can be obtained from the American Hereford Association Website [www.jrhereford.org](http://www.jrhereford.org). Please note that only one illustration or visual aid can be used. Types suggested or encouraged are charts, diagrams, props, inanimate models, puppets, posters etc. No electronic device, power point presentation, videos or slides may be used.

Winners in all divisions are eligible to compete in their age division in subsequent years unless they win at the Junior National Expo. They may then compete in the next age when they reach the age requirements. Senior national winners are ineligible in subsequent years.

## 2010 Preview Show General Information

### Facilities & Bedding:

- Bedding:** Bark bedding will be in ALL stalls. It may not be of real high quality so you may want to bring shavings or straw to top it. \$10 per head bedding\cleanup fee must be paid with entry.
- Straw:** No straw will be available for purchase.  
Straw ONLY at tie-outs!
- Gates:** Tie-outs gates will be provided – no tying to trailers  
Front gates in barn are lower – may want to bring way to tie up heads in stalls.

**Show T-shirts:** DelHawk Herefords are donating a show shirt to each exhibitor this year. Exhibitors are required to wear these shirts Sunday when exhibiting cattle.
